

92% of employers are looking for the skills and traits that students develop in study abroad settings²




JOB SECURITY


Intercultural Studies in Italy & Greece





Florence, Rome, Athens, & Delphi Region

Facilitate exploration of the roots of Western Civilization and the impact of classical Greek and Roman culture on modern history, philosophy, art and cuisine. Visit breathtaking ancient ruins, explore medieval neighborhoods untouched by time, and marvel at Renaissance masterpieces in world-renowned museums. Throughout your journey you'll connect with locals and get an insider's view of contemporary Mediterranean life in Italy and Greece.





- Take a guided tour of Florence, Italy, where you will see many sites such as Piazza della Signoria, Ponte Vecchio, and Basilica of Santa Croce, where Michelangelo, Machiavelli, Galileo and others are buried.
- See Rome's iconic landmarks such as The Colosseum, the Roman Forum (the former heart of the Roman Empire), the Trevi Fountain, and the Spanish steps.
- Take a guided tour of Vatican City, the headquarter of the Roman Catholic Church and the Pope. You will see Michelangelo's Sistine Chapel ceiling. The Sistine Chapel is a sight to behold for the five million people a year that visit.







Highlights

- Fly to Athens, the capital city of Greece known for being the birthplace of democracy, the Olympic Games, and the achievements of the Greek Empire. See Olympic Stadium, where the first Olympic athletes displayed physical strength as a way to honor and entertain the gods of Mount Olympus.
- Visit iconic landmarks of Athens, such as the Parthenon, an enduring symbol of Athenian democracy, the Temple of Athena Nike (one housing a gold statue of the goddess), and the Plaka District, a hillside area of the city with cobblestone streets and whitewashed homes.




Worry Free Enrollment Period



Upon her death, she generously established a trust to help Southern State students further their education.

Study Abroad scholarships are available up to \$1,500. | Deadline: January 10 | Selection by: January 17

Scholarship Criteria

- . Applicants must be attending Southern State in the Fall or Spring Semester prior to the trip
- · Applicants must have earned at least 6 college credit hours toward a SSCC degree or certificate.
- Minimum SSCC cumulative GPA requirement | 2.00
- Students must be registered for COLL 1110-Success on the Global Stage Summer course.
 - *Although applicants may be selected for the scholarship in January, registration in COLL 1110 will be verified before official payment is made.
- Students must be clear of any disciplinary issues with the College, and if a CCP high school student, must have verification from high school of no known conduct issues (see form attached).
- A personal interview is required.
- Preference will be given to students residing in Adams, Brown, Clinton, Fayette or Highland Counties.
