

# SSCC Inclusive Access

What is Inclusive Access?

**Inclusive Access (IA)** is a course materials and distribution model that embraces technology, affordability, and equity. It levels the playing field for all students by providing all required course materials for a course at one equal price to all students on an opt-out basis billed to their student account. Simply stated, your course materials are charged to your tuition as a textbook fee and you will have access to your digital materials on the first day of class.

SSCC has several Inclusive Access courses. A list of IA courses and their fees is on each semester's schedule. These prices may change as not all publishers have set their pricing when schedules are generated. Below is a sample of what you will see if your course is IA and you are trying to purchase the material from the bookstore website.

Once you register for an Inclusive Access course you will receive an email with some terminology you may not know. Below are some words that may be used when speaking about Inclusive Access.

**Opt-out:** This is the process of choosing to not participate in IA. There will be a link in your welcome letter to set up your account. Once in this account your IA course will appear with the option to Opt-out. Please only Opt-out if you have alternative access to the required material.

**Opt-in:** This is the process to rejoin the IA program. This option appears in place of the Opt-out button for any IA course that you have Opted-out of. This can be used if you find that you do not have access to the required material and want to rejoin the program.

**Brytewave Redshelf:** This is a digital textbook provider your digital textbook maybe housed on a digital bookshelf on this site. There should be a link to this site inside your course in Canvas. Alternatively, you can access the site directly at <https://brytewave.redshelf.com> by going through the password reset process with your **SSCC e-mail**. Once on the Brytewave Redshelf page select Login from the upper right hand of the screen. This box will appear if you have never had an account and do not have a temporary password you will need to do the password reset. If you have an account and have forgotten your password, you will need to reset your password.
